

Update from the Head of School

Good Day St. Anne's Families,

Just two weeks ago, we left for Spring Break expecting time to relax and re-energize in preparation for the remainder of the school year. In a moment's time, we found ourselves in the midst of something we could not have imagined. The Coronavirus has taken us into unchartered territory, a place with no historical reference from which to draw. In these unprecedented times, our priority is to continue doing what is best to support the health, safety, and well-being of our community. We will continue to abide by the recommendations laid out by the CDC and State of Delaware, and we recognize the current situation presents a myriad of challenges. We plan to meet those challenges head on.

We know that we will not be able to replicate the St. Anne's classroom learning experience; however, our faculty will work to deliver the best distance learning experience to our children. Today was our first opportunity to connect as a full faculty, and while CDC Guidelines prevented us from meeting as a group, we were able to meet virtually via Google Meet to begin reviewing and planning our online learning approach for Middle, Lower, and Primary School.
